#### Infrastructure Activities

- VHF Station at the Bunker
  - Beta Test of VHF Winlink Peer-to-Peer started 8/10
  - In process of selecting final frequency
- HF Station at the Bunker
  - Yaesu FT-950 Radio works on Receive
  - Plan to install a End Fed NVIS to test transmit
  - Then install computer and soundcard for HF Winlink
- Peoria Red Cross
  - Need to test all radios and periodically exercise
  - Computers there need to be updated



#### Peer-to-Peer Beta Test

- Peer-to-Peer (P2P) is a Winlink mode in which messages are sent from one station to another without any Internet in the middle – just radios
- The Kenwood D710 in main building sits idle most of the time – perfect for this application
- If you are interested, I will send details via email
- I can check the station remotely, also I get copies of your P2P messages in my email



#### P2P Beta Test – Brief Instructions

- Set your radio to the new frequency
- Compose a new "Peer-to-Peer Message", addressing it to W9PIA
- Open a Winlink Session, selecting "Packet P2P" in the drop down menu
- In the Connection Type box, set the station you are calling to be "W9PIA"
- Hit "Start"
- Watch screen for success or failure



### **Training Documentation**

- I sent an email on 06/15 with a form to be completed showing your training completion dates
- I have received and tabulated 9 forms
- FEMA Course dates should be in your email or on your certificates - Guessing at other dates is OK
- Does not matter which letter version of IS Courses you completed
- It is OK to simply report that you have nothing completed, some folks are just starting out
- Some folks only want to do Level 1 items, that is fine for weather spotting and community service events




## Replying to Winlink 213 Messages
