Infrastructure Activities

- VHF Station at the Bunker
 - Winlink VHF Computer is back in service
 - Beta Test of VHF Winlink Peer-to-Peer has resumed
- HF Station at the Bunker
 - Erected & Repositioned End Fed NVIS to test transmit
 - Yaesu FT-950 Radio works on Receive & Transmit
 - Not happy with antenna SWR too high for internal tuner
 - Next install computer and soundcard for HF Winlink
- Peoria Red Cross
 - Need to test all radios and periodically exercise
 - Computers have been updated, ready to reinstall

 - See December 2023 slides for instructions to connect

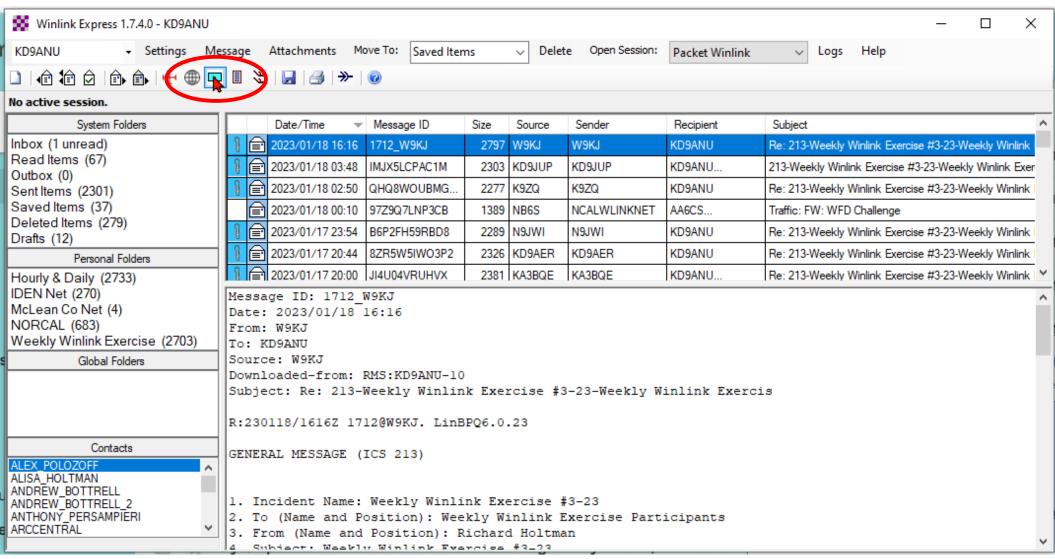


Winlink News 2/2

 - Minor problem fixes and new features
 - toolbar icon to display a map showing where the currently-selected message originated
 - option to Winlink Express Setup screen to automatically install updates without prompting



Icon – Message Origination





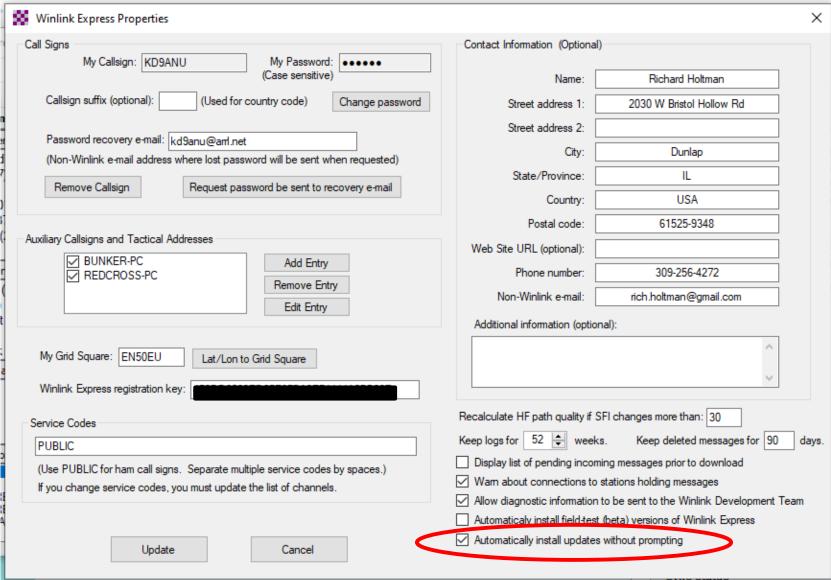
Icon – Message Origination
